If it's listening to, rather than making, music he prefers, then check out the world's first solar powered **DAB radio** from Roberts (**8, £79.99**). These ingenious little numbers have integrated solar panels which charge the battery pack and then last for up to 27 hours.

For clothing, frankandfaith.com support the British textile industry by only selling items made here in the UK from organic and sustainable materials. This **charcoal stripe**

jumper (9, £52) is a great mixture of soft cotton combined with boating chic design.

In terms of eco shoes, you can't beat po-zu.com, whose literally **biodegradable slippers and trainers (10, from £70)** contain a coconut 'mattress' filled with air pockets that mould to the shape of your feet. Even their unique shoe boxes can be used as trays to plant seeds, which can be then be plonked straight into the ground to biodegrade naturally around your seedlings.

If he likes a Fair Trade tippie, the award winning **Argentinian Soluna red wine** is a velvety Malbec with aromas of plums and blackberries (**11, £9.95** from ethical-superstore.com). For something stronger, try a bottle of **Papagayo spiced rum**, flavoured with spices, vanilla, ginger and a hint of chilli (**12, £17.95** ethicalsuperstore.com).

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
